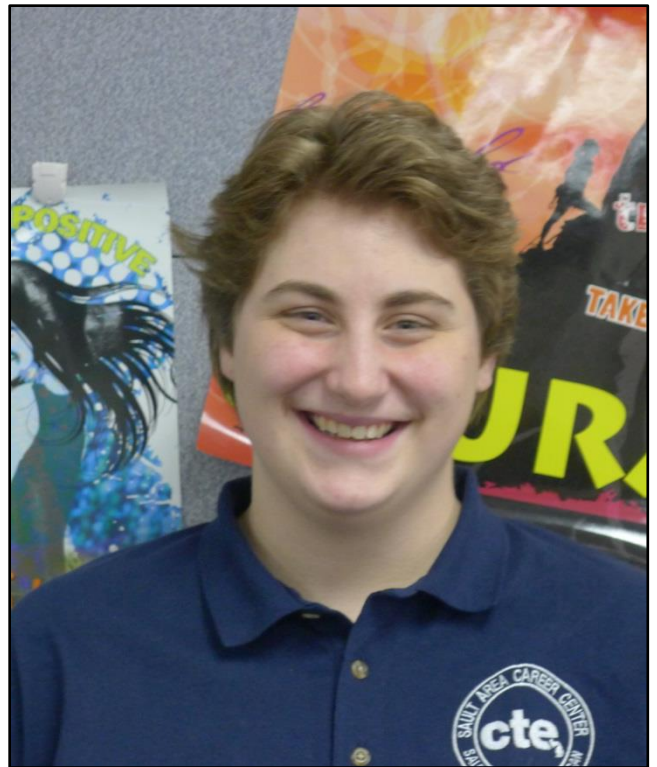


# Ruby Lucas

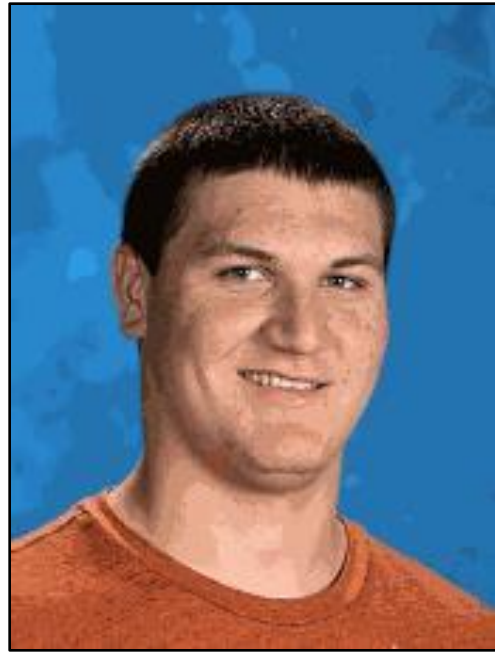
